Diary of Anne Frank –The dramatization by Frances Goodrich and Albert Hackett of the world’s most famous diary won the Pulitzer in 1956. **February 17-19, 23-26**

Next to Normal – The 2010 prize winner is a powerful rock musical that grapples with mental illness in a suburban family and expands the scope of subject matter for musicals. **April 7-9, 13-15**

Crimes of the Heart – Winning in 1981, Beth Henley’s warm-hearted and brilliantly imaginative play examines the plight of three Mississippi sisters betrayed by their passions. **June 9-11, 15-18**

A Chorus Line – One singular sensation, 17 aspiring dancers, 8 spots to fill and 5 collaborators winning the 1976 Pulitzer for Drama. **August 11-13, 17-20**

Cat on a Hot Tin Roof –Greed! Superficiality! Mendacity! Decay! Sexual desire! Repression! Death! What more could you want from Tennessee Williams’ prize winner from 1955. **October 13-15, 19-22**




